Please note this is a children's facility! There is no foul language allowed and we must be careful about what we say, and how we say it!

### **Qualifications:**

- Must have already, and continue to work the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous
  - Have a minimum of One full Year (weekends count) of Sobriety.
- Must not have any Criminal charges on your record in the last five years, including gun charges, sexual assault charges, any assault and or battery charges, any active violence at all including abuse.
  - This is a six-month commitment, one week per month for the full six months.
- Must attend a “meet and greet” with the director that we will arrange if you are willing and able.
- You WILL have to be screened for fingerprints, background check and on the sex registry.

This is not an option.
